Despite a decade of reduced military spending at the close of the Cold War, the challenges of the new millennium have inspired the vigorous development of new weapons technology. This book graphically compares more than 300 different weapons systems: air superiority fighters, bolt-action sniper rifles, air-to-surface missiles, main battle tanks, tracked personnel carriers, nuclear submarines, attack helicopters, strike aircraft, bullpup assault rifles, and personal defense weapons from 1990 to the present, as deployed in the Gulf War and the Iraq War, in Afghanistan, and in the Middle East. Through captioned photographs, drawings, and specially created graphical charts, this highly visual reference book compares these various weapons directly, allowing the reader to see the relative capabilities: maximum speed, effective range, armor penetration, rate of fire, weapons caliber, magazine capacity, bomb load of each fighting force's materiel. 224.
